As we hover just below 100, we decided to hold our worship service tomorrow. We are employing safety measures to reduce the risk of infection and ask that you use your wise judgment to decide for your families. We encourage everyone to wash your hands or use a hand sanitizer as you arrive and as you leave the building.

Social Distancing!

We also recommend that we observe social distancing as appropriate in our services. Maintain a distance of 1-2 meters away from a different family or member if our facility allows it.

Implementing handwashing and social distancing among children is more challenging, we therefore recommend that children ages 10 and below stay home. We understand this might mean our families with kids will have to miss church this Sunday. Brian will send out an email later today with possible materials for your kids should you want to do a family teaching or activity. We are also putting The Way meetings on Fridays on hold.

Linger Longer on hold!

To further promote safety and allay fears among our members, we are putting the Linger Longer on hold until COVID-19 is controlled. We are assessing what else we need to do and we will continue to respond as the situation develops.

We are continuing to work on having the capability for online presence in the coming weeks. Tomorrow we will hold a live service and post the audio online as scheduled, even earlier if we
